# NOSE-IN PARKING

---

Beginning July 1, all vehicles on campus must park nose-in and plate-out. **No back-in or pull-through parking is allowed.** Failure to park nose-in may result in a citation.

## WHO

Everyone — students, staff, faculty, visitors and vendors — will need to park nose-in. This applies to vehicles and motorcycles.

## WHERE

All parking garages and surface lots will require nose-in parking.

## WHEN

The new parking rule goes into effect **July 1, 2019.**

## WHY

This policy strengthens campus safety and promotes a parking-friendly campus.

### **VIRTUAL PERMITS – COMING SOON**

In the future, UCF will no longer issue physical parking decals, hangtags and permits. Instead, your license plate will act as a virtual permit. License plates will be used for all parking pass options — annual, semester and daily.
